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2020 Summer Camp Safety Guidelines & Policies

Summer Science Camp Drop off: 8:30am - 9:00am

- No adults/parents in the building. Tables will be set outside for signing in and signing out – tables will be 6 ft. apart
 - o ONE parent - **wearing a mask** - will bring the camper to the sign-in area
 - o Sign-in on the appropriate clipboard
 - o Signed Waiver and Policy form received (from online registration)
 - o Camper temperature will be taken with a non-contact thermometer before the adult departs
 - o A teacher/counselor-wearing a mask, will take the child inside:
 - ▶ take the camper to wash hands
 - ▶ take the camper to their camp room
- Camp rooms will be sprayed with germicide while children are on the playground and again at the end of the day
- Campers presenting symptoms of illness during the day will be quarantined. The ill camper will need to be picked-up within 30-45 minutes. Parents must have a phone number on file - that will be answered during camp hours.
- Anytime your camper will be absent please call NDC: 713-667-6550
- If a camper has a fever, but no other symptoms, that camper must stay home for 48 hours after the fever is gone (without the aid of fever reducers).
- If a camper has a fever with symptoms, they must stay home for seven days after onset.
- If a camper comes in contact with anyone with COVID-19 symptoms, they must stay home for 14 days.
- If a camper develops COVID-19, during camp or after attending camp, NDC must be notified, by phone, immediately – 713-667-6550.
- No toys of any kind will be allowed at the Center.
- Campers must bring their own labeled water bottle.

Summer Science Camp Pick up: 2:00pm - 2:30pm

- No adults/parents in the building. Campers will meet parents outside.
- ONE parent - **wearing a mask** - will sign your camper out
