2023 Dates & Camp Descriptions:

Jun 5 - 9 & Jun 12 - 16 Into the Trees

Come explore the forests of the world with us as we have a look at trees, forests, and the animals that live in them. We'll learn to identify and care for native Texas trees. We'll encounter forest and tree dwelling animals out in the park, and live animals in the classroom. We'll also learn about different forest types around the world.

Jun 19 - 23 & Jun 26 - Jun 30 Tracks and Scat

Become an animal tracker and learn how to identify animals by the signs they leave behind in nature. You'll investigate tracks and make some of your own in this camp full of tips and techniques naturalists use to study animals in the wild. We'll also take a peek at animal poop. Everybody poops, and poop can be a great storyteller of where animals live, where and when they move in their habitat, what they have been eating, and more!



Jul 10 - Jul 14 & Jul 17 - Jul 21 Creepy Crawlies

Join us as we get to know the world's spineless wonders. In outdoor rambles and classroom investigations, we'll encounter a wide variety of invertebrate animals. Worms, insects, spiders, centipedes, and octopuses... oh my!



Kids, you need a time and place where you can connect with nature and have fun making big messes, and this camp is it! Feel mud between your toes, dig in the dirt with your hands, play with sticks, and more during fun days of messy play at camp. You'll hose down and wash up before pick-up so the mess stays with us! A win-win for you and for your parents!



Aug 7 - 11 & Aug 14 - 18 World of Water

Water covers most of the surface of the Earth, and there are multitudes of animals that live in water. Join us on an aquatic adventure, as we discover the lives of animals that live in oceans, lakes, rivers and ponds from around the world.

MINI-CAMPS

Half day camps perfect for young or first time campers. Hands-on activities, games, art projects, new friends, and animal encounters will give your kiddo a taste of what summer camp at the Nature Discovery Center is all about.

Park Explorer Pack Loaner Backpack Program

We've loaded 5 themed loaner backpacks up with tools, educational resources, and fun activities that you can use to create your own adventure out on our trails. You get to decide which activities and tools look interesting to you! Complete one activity or do them all. We hope you have a great time exploring the park!



Park Explorer Pack Themes

- Birds Learn about basic biology and behavior of birds through investigations and games, try to identify birds in the park, design a new bird, try some bird yoga, & more!
- Insects & Invertebrates Explore life under a log, catch and observe insects and their other invertebrate neighbors, play bug bingo, and learn a bee dance among other activities.
- Pond Life Dipnet for fish, tadpoles, and aquatic insiects, discover a food chain, survey pond life, use your senses to explore Cypress Pond, color a pond scene, and more!
- Trees Examie tree cookies, strike a tree pose, go on a tree based scavenger hunt or two, make leaf rubbings, start a tree journal, or play a game with trees in the park.
- Wildflowers & Pollinators Learn about the flowers pollinators prefer, go on a flower or pollination scavenger hunt, take a closer look at flower parts, catch a pollinator!

Greater Houston Area 'Swift Night Out' Events





Keep your eyes out for family friendly 'Swift Night Out' (SNO) events this fall. SNO Events are typically held across the Greater Houston Area on both weekday and weekend evenings starting between 7 and 7:30 pm from the end of August through September. At each event, we will watch Chimney Swifts swoop and soar over their roosts and count them as they enter their chimneys. We often count over 500 Chimney Swifts in some locations at this time of year!
