Henshaw House History

The Henshaw House serves as the classroom and administrative office of the Nature Discovery Center.

- * 1925 The house was constructed as a single story home by Earl Edwards, prominent Houston businessman, on a four acre plot at the corner of Evergreen and Avenue A (now Newcastle) in Bellaire.
- 1929 The home was purchased and later renovated by Frank Henshaw, Jr., who served as Mayor of the City of Bellaire from 1936 1937 and later as City Commissioner from 1945 1947.
- 1981 The Henshaw estate was listed for sale by Henshaw's heirs
- 1983 After a grassroots fundraising campaign, the estate was purchased and renovated by the Friends of Bellaire Parks and then turned over to the City of Bellaire as a community gathering space. The house quickly became the home of the Nature Discovery Center, and the surrounding estate became Russ Pitman Park, a public nature park maintained by the Center.
- 2014 The house and adjacent Pavilion area were renovated again during Phase I of NDC's Gateway capital campaign. Gateway Phase II, completed in 2017, included renovations to the park.

About the Nature Discovery Center

Our mission at the Hana and Arthur Ginzbarg Nature Discovery Center is to ignite life-long curiosity, understanding, and respect for nature through education. Since 1988, we have inspired and educated visitors of all ages about the wonders of nature and science through low cost hands-on, inquiry-based programs, outdoor investigations, and Discovery Rooms which are open to the public free of charge. Through outreach, we extend our education programs to locations across Greater Houston Area.

In 2024, we provided education programs and opportunities for encounters with nature to over 15,600 students and adults. To further extend our reach and expand nature play opportunities for the Greater Houston Area, we also launched a \$2 million capital campaign in 2024 to construct the Enchanted Woods Nature Play Area an the south end of the park property.

Today, we continue our good work with the benefit of financial and volunteer support from our community. NDC is a stand-alone non-profit organization not affiliated with the City of Bellaire.
